














Overall daily smoking rates continue to be very low








(L) A typical tobacco product display. (R) A tobacco display following the implementation of the ban in Australia (www.tobaccoinaustralia.org.au).












Year 10 (14-15 years) REGULAR smoking and vaping prevalence



Year 10 (14-15 years) DAILY smoking and vaping prevalence


